**MATTEO RICCI:
A MODEL OF DIALOGUE**

Matteo Ricci was born in Macerata on 6 October 1552. Pope Benedict XVI writes: "He was gifted with profound faith and extraordinary cultural and academic genius." Ricci was likewise "**a model of dialogue and respect for the beliefs of others**" and "made friendship the style of his apostolate during his twenty-eight years in China."

This year we celebrate the 400th anniversary of the death of the Italian Jesuit missionary, Matteo Ricci, the most respected, known, and loved foreigner in China. Today, his figure once again shines in the country to which he devoted his life.

To follow Ricci's model of dialogue, we have invited a Bishop, a priest, a sister and a lay couple from China to update us on the Church in China and to explore with us possible partnerships in mission.
